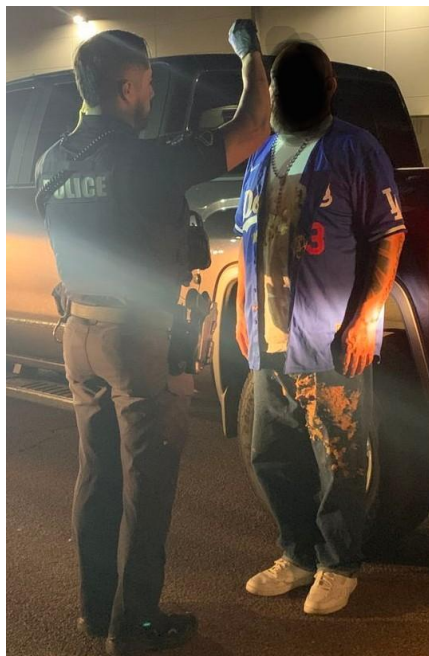

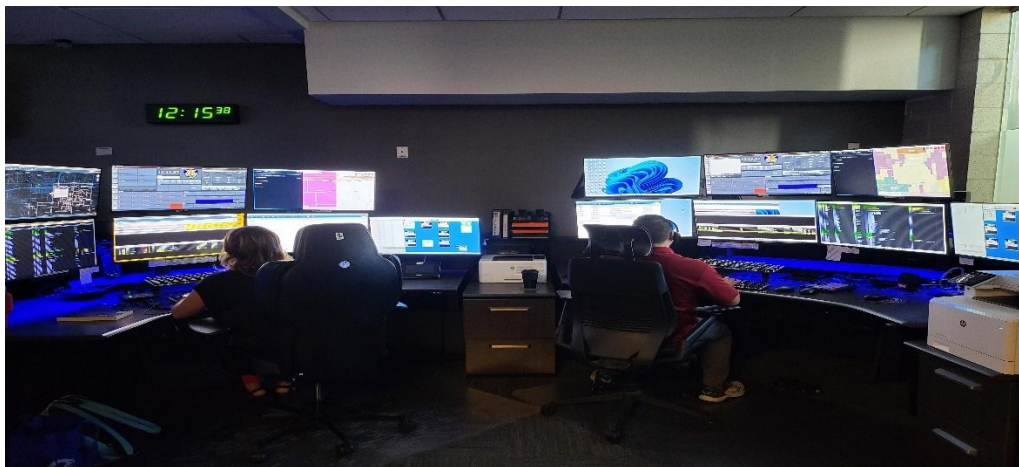
- Total calls processed by Tolleson Police Communications in September 2025: **7,306**
